The Larry Adams International Experience Award

The Center for International Studies offers this monetary award, honoring Dr. Larry Adams, to acknowledge undergraduate students who integrate their academic study-abroad experience into meaningful engagement upon their return with a significant project or activity that exemplifies internationalization.

Criteria for awarding a project or activity include: significance of the project/activity; impact on self and others; and on-going impact of projects. A faculty panel will review all submissions to select the winner.

Sydney DeSpain (2015) led a book drive for children in Ghana.

Madeleine Bailey (2016) raised money to combat Human Trafficking.

Myrah Osmani (2017) worked with local refugees in Fort Worth.

Eric Ngo (2018) raised awareness of rhino crisis in S Africa.
